
As mentioned above, the mobility will take place in Pasarón de la Vera, a municipality located in Extremadura. The campsite "Las Castellanas" are the facilities selected for the activities. These facilities are equipped with:

- The capacity of the camp is 80 places.
- 2 Bungalows with 8 places adapted for disabled people.
- Infirmary module
- Dining room
- Kitchen
- Storeroom
- Activities room
- Both the cabins and the bungalows are airconditioned (hot air pumps). There is also heating/air pump in the dining room and activity room.









IMPORTANT INFORMATION



The participants will be chosen on the basis of their social competences, their interest in the topic and their linguistic compentence in English. Moreover, gender balance will be taken into account in order to organise an equal and diverse mobility.



The project will run from 29th May 2024, the day of arrival, until 7th June 2024, the end of the project. Volunteers will arrive in Spain from their respective countries by plane. The closest airport with the most air connections is Madrid..



For Spanish members, accommodation and meals are covered for those days. The official language of the course will be English.
